PURPOSE OF THE STUDY


- Advance DRCOG Regional Transportation Plan through Corridor Planning Program


- 755 (25 fatal or serious injury) crashes on corridor (2017-2021)



REGIONAL TRAVEL ON SOUTH BOULDER ROAD








TRIP LENGTH AT LOCATIONS ON THE CORRIDOR






POPULATION AND 2050 FORECAST






EMPLOYMENT AND 2050 FORECAST






DRCOG EQUITY INDEX: TOTAL SCORE






ROADWAY NETWORK





TRANSIT NETWORK + DASH RIDERSHIP






TRANSIT SPEEDS


Top Slowest Locations:

 - >35 MPH






BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES



- Bike lane present through City of Boulder with a bikeable shoulder through Boulder County
- Generally more comfortable pedestrian amenities on the south side
- No sidewalks in Boulder County section



BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES CONT.




- Bike lane through both Louisville and Lafayette
- Sidewalks or multiuse paths present on both sides
- More multiuse paths (wider pedestrian amenities) on south side



- Crashes analyzed from 2017-2021
- Analysis determined intersections with higher-thanexpected crash frequencies
- Severe or fatal crashes activity higher than expected at:
 - Cherryvale
 Road
 - 76th Street
 - Centennial
 Drive
 - 120th Street






ESTIMATED RIGHT-OF-WAY
